

Dear Parents,

Over the summer holidays a team of staff members worked extremely hard to reconfigure some of our office spaces to ensure greater efficiency and to create further intervention spaces.

One space we were keen to establish was a calming reflection zone, a space where children have the opportunity to regulate and regroup after an emotionally challenging time either in the classroom or the playground. Once the space had been created, we were looking at how to fund the resources needed for this room. Ms Anthony applied to the Chalkhill Community Trust Fund for a grant. This week we were informed that we will receive £2,500.00 for this project. I am extremely grateful to Ms Anthony and to the Chalkhill Community Trust Fund for enabling us to create this vital space in our school.

It was wonderful to see so many of you joining us in school on Friday. I was pleased to see our Year 6 parents joining us to appreciate the amazing assembly presented by Year 6K to celebrate the European Day of Languages. In a school where over 84% of the children learning English as an additional language, it is especially wonderful to take the time to celebrate diversity.

We also offered a Macmillan coffee morning to all our parents on Friday. School staff had baked and donated cupcakes, tray bakes and biscuits for all to enjoy. Thanks to your generosity, we managed to raise £90.00 for this worthwhile course.

Our focus this year is on expanding our outdoor learning offer in and out of school. To this end, we are encouraging teachers to arrange local trips such as to the Welsh Harp (Year 4 this week) and to the Civic Centre library. For any trip to take place we do need parent volunteers to ensure we can keep all children safe. Your support in this area is very much appreciated.

Also, we are re-launching in-school volunteering opportunities for parents. If you are interested in volunteering, please, speak to Ms Anthony. We need parents to support the academic learning in school, but also need parents who would be willing to support gardening or cooking projects.

Finally, a reminder that a school start time of 08:45 hours, means your child should be in school ready to learn. Too many of your children are still just about arriving at the gate at this time. The school gates are open from 08:30 hours to allow your child to be in school on time. Currently, we are a little lenient with the closing of the gates. This will change soon.

Please, ensure that your child is in school on time.

I hope, that you and your family get an opportunity to enjoy the late summer warmth and sunshine this weekend.
