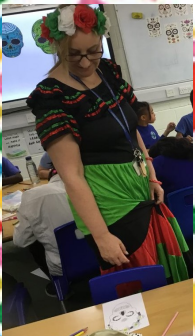
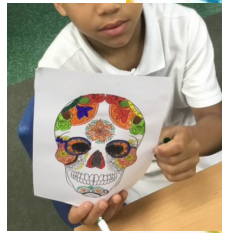




On Tuesday we looked at

“Mascaras de Calaveras”.



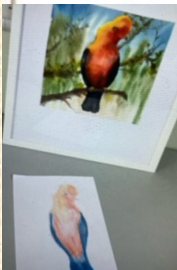




On Thursday members of the Rimanakuy community came to Chalkhill and taught us about the vibrant Culture of Peru.
