Each class has been learning about an inspirational black woman. Our pupils and teachers are busy preparing to exhibit what they have learned. We are planning to stage an exhibition early in November to invite our school community to come and celebrate with us.

The week ended with an amazing assembly by Year 1G, celebrating National Confidence Day. Our youngest learners demonstrated their confidence in presenting poems about their uniqueness and about things that bind us all together. Thank you to Ms Gracio and her team, thank you to the parents and thank you to the wonderful pupils in Year 1 for ending the half term on a high.

Next half term promises to be as exciting and filled with learning opportunities for all. I would like to point out that half way through next half term there are two INSET days, where the school is closed to pupils (24th and 27th of November).


